Base Station Battery Warning



Overview

To reset a SimpliSafe low battery warning, access the Base Station with a Phillips head screwdriver, replace NiMH rechargeable batteries, check for corrosion, ensure proper installation, and contact SimpliSafe support for persistent warnings post-reset. What if a base station doesn't turn on?

If the base station is plugged into a working outlet (and the power cable isn't damaged) but still isn't turning on, try restarting the base station. To do that, Turn over the base station and unscrew the battery cover using a screwdriver. Remove the batteries from the base station and wait a minute or two before reinserting them.

Why is my SimpliSafe base station not charging?

If you are having issues charging your SimpliSafe Base Station's batteries, below are a few possible causes: You may be using the wrong type of batteries. SimpliSafe Base Stations use Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) rechargeable batteries, hence why the base stations can be recharged. If you use the wrong batteries, your base station might not charge.

Why is my base station not charging?

Your base station cable is damaged. A less likely but still possible reason is that the base station's charging cable is damaged. Check for any breakage, cuts, or burns in the cable. If your cable looks damaged, this may be the reason the batteries aren't charging. The batteries are bad.

When does the light on my base station turn off?

The light on your base station is designed to always be on when the device is working. Your base station will only turn off when one of the following happens: When the base station is off due to a battery drain. When an alarm goes off, this feature is designed to ensure your base station doesn't look conspicuous.

Why does my base station keep announcing 'alarm off'?

If your base station keeps announcing “Alarm Off”, check to ensure your Key Fob isn’t being pressed (if you have one). Your SimpliSafe Key Fob can arm/disarm your alarm system with the press of a button. If the Key Fob is pressed (knowingly or unknowingly), this could cause an “Alarm Off” announcement.
