Mongolia s telecommunications base station wind power expansion



Overview

With a total investment of 98.8 billion RMB, the project plans to build 8 million kW of photovoltaic capacity and 4 million kW of wind power, supported by 4 million kW of coal power and 5 kWh of new-type energy storage. Does Mongolia have an economic potential for solar and wind energy?
